

**RAPID CITY REGIONAL AIRPORT NOTICE OF PROPOSED  
AIRPORT CONCESSIONS DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE  
GOALS FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEARS 2023 - 2025**

Rapid City Regional Airport (RCRA) has established an Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) program in accordance with regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), 49 CFR Part 23.

It is the policy of RCRA to ensure that ACDBEs as defined in Part 23, have an equal opportunity to receive and participate in concession opportunities. It is also our policy:

1. To ensure nondiscrimination in the award and administration of opportunities for concessions by airports receiving DOT financial assistance;
2. To create a level playing field on which ACDBEs can compete fairly for opportunities for concessions;
3. To ensure that our ACDBE program is narrowly tailored in accordance with applicable law;
4. To ensure that only firms that fully meet this part's eligibility standards are permitted to participate as ACDBEs at RCRA;
5. To help remove barriers to the participation of ACDBEs in opportunities for concessions at RCRA; and
6. To provide appropriate flexibility to our airports in establishing and providing opportunities for ACDBEs.

Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. Part 23, the RCRA hereby gives notice of its intent to propose an overall percentage goal for participation by Airport Concessions Disadvantaged Business Enterprises for the federal fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022, and ending September 30, 2025, as follows:

Non-Rental Car Concessions Goal:	1.30%
Rental Car Concessions Goal:	2.12%

Beginning the date of this notice, and continuing for 30 days thereafter, a statement regarding this proposed goal and how it was selected is available for inspection at RCRA Administration Office.
